- Representatives include: Office of Undergraduate Education, Academic Support Resources, Admissions, Office for Equity and Diversity, Housing and Residential Life, Office for Student Affairs, and 2-3 Associate Deans
- Meets every 3-4 weeks



STANDING COMMITTEES

College Retention Committee

- Connect work happening in colleges to overall enrollment strategy
- Representatives include individuals doing retention work in the colleges
- Meets quarterly

Curriculum Committee

- Assist in supporting the efforts and initiatives of the Strategic Enrollment Management Committee
- Identify gaps, trends, and/or ideas related to the curriculum and student degree progress
- Brings items/issues to Strategic Enrollment Management Committee as appropriate
- Committee members will be identified by OUE
- Committee will be chaired by the Associate Dean for the Curriculum
- · Meets monthly

Data Committee

- Assist in articulating research questions to guide projects
- Conduct data mining and analysis to support work and projects of Strategic Enrollment Management Committee
- Representatives include: Office of Undergraduate Education, Office of Institutional Research, Academic Support Resources -Student Degree Progress, Office of Measurement Services
- Meets every two weeks

Multicultural Student Success Committee

- Assist in supporting the efforts and initiatives of the Strategic Enrollment Management Committee
- Identify gaps, trends, and/or ideas to enhance support of various student populations and their intersecting identities
- Brings items/issues to Strategic Enrollment Management Committee as appropriate
- Representatives include some committee members from the Multicultural Outreach Committee
- Committee co-chairs could include Office of Undergraduate Education and Office for Equity and Diversity
- · Meets monthly
